

In school we will be looking at stories that have Kings and Queens in them. We will be starting with Cinderella and then looking at The Princess and the Pea, but we will also be looking at lots of other stories during the week.

We will be:

- making castles thinking carefully about the shapes that you are using. We will be looking at rectangles and squares and noting the difference in the properties. We will be spotting the longer sides and the number of points or corners on the shapes
- making someone ruler for the day and writing down some of the rules that they would make if they were king or queen
- looking at dragons and drawing and painting them
- using matchsticks to make shapes and then making them out of other materials
- looking at the pictures of the kings and queens and then drawing pictures of ourselves as the king or queen
- making magic spells like they have in some stories
- thinking about princess power, have a look at the letter from the princess
- making swords, crowns and all things royal
