This week...

- ⌘ In English – finished our biography work and have copied these up in best to be presented on our Stargazers display as an example of our Take Care work.
- ⌘ In Spelling and Handwriting – ie and ei words. We wrote some really random ie and ei stories on Thursday using our researched words. Do you know what a villain, feign, besiege and kaleidoscope mean?
- ⌘ In Maths - we have looked at changing mixed fractions to improper and back again, and have challenged ourselves in problem solving and reasoning with our partner.

Our new topic until Christmas is 'Time Travellers' and I will be reading 'Tom's Midnight Garden' to the children alongside this. We will also use this book to weave and enrich our English lessons.

Useful spellings information:

We have a Recovery element to our spellings, meaning that for this first Autumn term we are recapping and recovering areas of the curriculum missed towards the end of Y5, weaving in Y6 spellings as we go. **Spellings will be tested every Friday.** Any words which the children have spelt incorrectly will be written in their diaries and will need to be practised at home for retesting the following week. If they have no words in their diary, the likelihood is they achieved full marks on their test. As we move through the term there may be additional spellings that the children bring home as homework.
