# Sparkle and shine



This week we have finished our topic "Sparkle and shine", looking at the Jewish festival of Hanukkah and the different celebrations that happen in autumn and winter. Discussing how each festival has different types of lights and lamps to help people celebrate, finishing with making our own Diva lamps. The children have particularly liked making 3D firework pictures dropping paint onto glue and salt, adding labels with the sounds they make.

The children have enjoyed learning the story of Goldilocks and the three bears in Talk 4 writing and the actions that go with the story. Goldilocks gobbling down the porridge as quick as she can has caused a lot of laughter.

We have started to learn the songs for our Nativity, and we are sure you will begin to hear them sung around the house in the weeks to come!

In phonics we have continued to look at our phonemes, either recapping some of the sounds to consolidate the learning or beginning to learn some of the digraphs we find at the end of some words (please look at the sheet in their reading diaries).

In Maths we have continued to subitize 1,2 and 3, looking at the composition of these and comparing the different quantities. The children have done a great job of recognising the amounts without counting and telling us how they know the amount in front of them.

Finally, the children should have come home on Thursday with a sticker giving you access to the Christmas cards they have produced at school. This gives you the opportunity to order Christmas cards and other various items with your child's artwork. Please let us know if it didn't make it home. You should have also received a Parent's Evening form.

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#### Next Week:

We will be starting our new topic, "Once upon a time". This project supports children to develop a love of stories and reading. It encourages children to learn, retell and act out familiar and traditional tales

including Cinderella, Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs and The Three Billy Goats Gruff..

#### We will also be:

- changing parts of Goldilocks to enable us to write our own versions the following week.
- continue to learn our Nativity songs
- continue to form our letters correctly in handwriting.
- In maths, we will be looking at shapes and their properties, starting with circles and triangles.

#### PF

PE is still on Wednesday. This week has seen the start of our gymnastics unit and we been looking at different ways of travelling and balancing.
