We have had another great week. The children have enjoyed looking at what makes a friend and have particularly enjoyed making a friendship tree and hanging on their friendship word leaves. We have some fantastic photos of the children engaging in the topic this week, making their friends in dough and loose parts, playing in the friendship $caf\acute{e}$ and investigating measuring words in maths. We will put these in our floor book and will share this with you on parents' eve.

In phonics we have started to learn our phonemes, this week looking at the sounds s,a,t and p. Please look at our class page for some more information about this. You will notice we have given the children a reading diary this week, we will stick the weekly sounds in them and pop them on the website too. They have been telling us they have been doing fab phonics this week!

We have also been looking at being "take care", taking care of ourselves, our class and each other.

Next Week:

We will be doing lots of activities around "People who help us", both the emergency services and the people in our community.

We will also be:

- matching and sorting in maths, using the book
- "The button box" by Margarette Reid to support their learning.
- learning the story, Mr Wiggle and Mr Waggle in our talk 4 writing. A fun way of learning to retell a story using actions and beginning to look at how a story is structured.
- looking at the local community on google maps and making our own "messy maps"
- continue to write letters and practise holding a pencil correctly.
