The children have en joyed learning about scratch coding this week in our IT session — I am sure that many will want to explore this further at home now they have some good, basic knowledge.

## This week's other learning:

- Maths as well as keeping times tables ticking along, the children have worked on finding multiples and common multiples as well as factors and common factors of a range of numbers,
- English we are now well into our new unit of work based around the gruesome text 'Beowulf'. As well as
  finding examples of Kennings structures, we have highlighted different features of the model text and written our
  own ideas based on these.
- History this week, we have discussed the hierarchy of power during the period of the Shang Dynasty.
- P.E. Yoga and outdoor multi-sports.
- Science This week, we began to look at the solar system and the children thought of their own mnemonic rhymes to help them remember the order from the sun's position.
- Art we have experimented with different tints and shades by gradually adding white to a primary colour to lighten it.
