This week's other learning:

- Maths as well as keeping times tables ticking along, we have been working on multiplying and dividing whole numbers and decimals by 10, 100 and 100 as well as doubling and halving.
- English As we come towards the end of our 'Beowulf' unit, the children have planned, written and edited their hot write story about defeating an ogre!
- History this week, we have continued to look at everyday life during the Shang Dynasty in closer detail.

- Spanish My family and revision of numbers to 100.
- Art we have used water colours to closely match shades and tones in sections of landscape paintings.
