- Maths as well as keeping times tables ticking along, the children have completed an end of unit assessment on addition and subtraction as well as beginning our new unit of work on multiplication, beginning with factors.

We have also started a new 'Talk for Writing' unit based around the fiction text 'Beowulf'. This began with a 'cold write' which involved creating a story about defeating a monster or mythical creature.
- Geography We have started to look at vegetation belts around the world.
- P.E. Yoga and outdoor multi-sports.
- Science an investigation based on testing water resistance.
