A summary of this week's learning...

Subject	Key learning points
English	Wartime poetry and expanded noun phrases
Maths	Inverse operations and multi-step problems
Topic	The Blitz, geographical targets of the Blitz and evacuees
RE	Jewish experiences of the Holocaust
Art / DT	The Blitz artwork and gas mask cases

The children have been working on some wartime poems, since we looked at Flanders's Fields as a class on Monday. I am so impressed with the poetry that the children came up with! These poems will be available to read on the class page shortly.

On Thursday and Friday, we delved deep into history and took part in a range of activities focusing on World War 2. The children even had an exciting trip down the corridor to the 'school museum', looking at interesting historical artefacts...

Things to note...

- General information is available on the class page.
- If you are isolating or off for any other reason, there is a home learning section on the class page for you to follow along with what we are doing in school.
- Children should be reading three times a week at home, which they can record in their school diaries. Each read counts towards your child achieving a reading certificate.
- Homework should be completed in homework books to a 'Take Care' standard.

Homework for this week:

Spellings – Your children will have 15 spellings written down in their diaries or homework books to learn for this week. Each child has completely personal spelling lists. Once they have been tested, they write down the next set of words from the statutory spelling lists and any that they got wrong on that particular week. Spellings are tested each Friday.

Maths – Complete the questions on the worksheet, focusing on multi-step problems involving addition and subtraction. You can either write your answers on the sheet, or write them out in your book if you would prefer.

English / Topic – I would like you to research 'Women in World War Two'. In the form of a fact sheet, leaflet, poster, or report, you need to explain the role that women played during the war. How were women treated? Why did they not fight in the war on the battlefield? I would like presentation to be key in this piece of homework. Please take care of your handwriting, any drawings and take your time.
