- Projects – Take Care expectation.



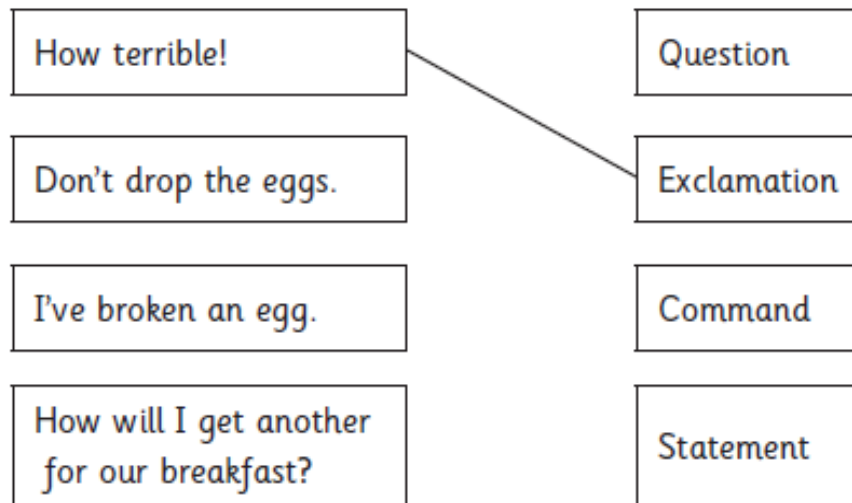
Year 2 SATS

- Talk to your child about what they have learnt at school and what book(s) they are reading. Listen to your child read – ask questions about text.



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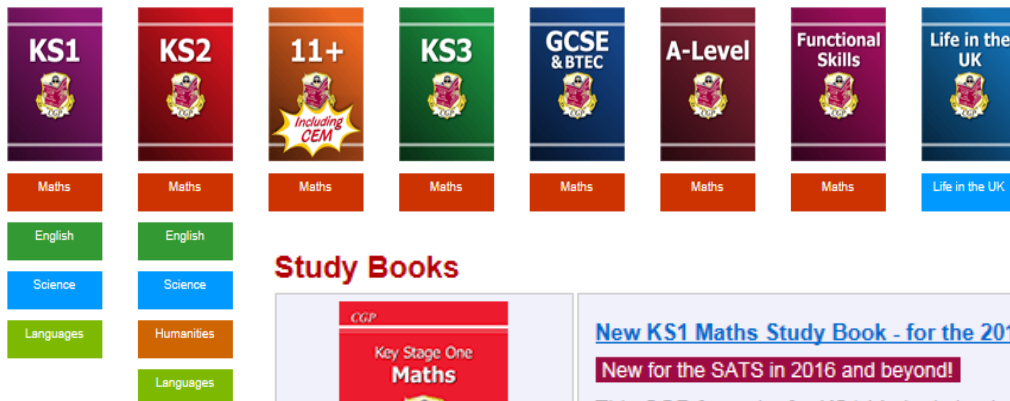


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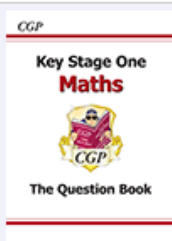
