

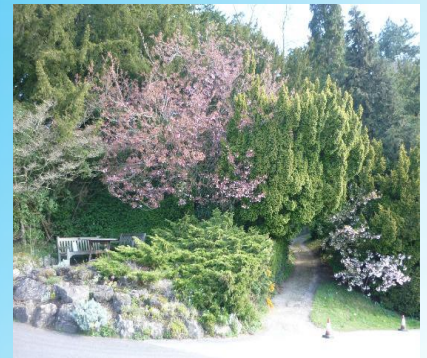
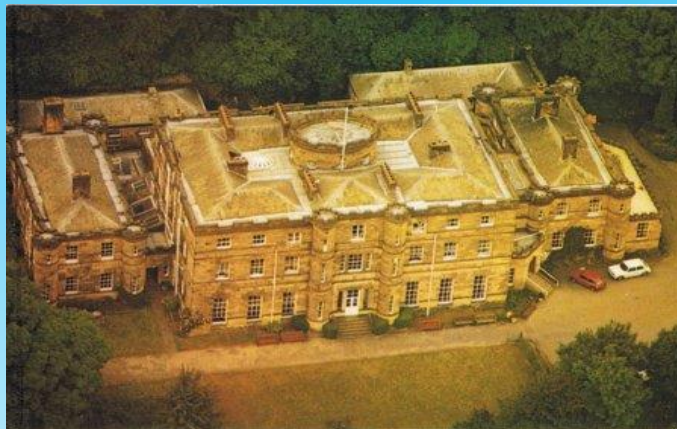

# Itinerary: Thursday

- 8.30 Arrive at school; leave luggage in Class 2 and enter the hall to give register with LW, pocket money with LF and medicine (if applicable) with DM/SC.
- 9.00 Depart; we ask adults to say goodbyes while in the hall, then walk their child's suitcases out to the coach and then we follow on in a line and get straight onto the bus.
- 10.30 Crich Tramway Museum. Activities to include: Minibeast workshop, tram rides, exhibition hall and woodland/sculpture walk. Opportunities to visit the shop.

# Kit List
