

Oddizzi UmbUzo Challenge!

As you are aware, Friends of St. Peter's (our PTA) make it possible to subscribe to ODDIzzi, a fantastic geography and general knowledge website. This can be accessed at home or school and is part of our enrich curriculum. Classes can have ClassPals in schools all over the world, learn about current affairs in a child friendly way and use the site to resource and extend their learning. Earlier this year, Ellie Andrews Wragg and Jessica Watson (now both in Year 6) ran a highly successful lunchtime Oddizzi club for KSI pupils that proved such fun a waiting list for new members had to be drawn up and record numbers of Gold Oddizzi certificates were issued.

We are now having a whole school challenge to see which Year group can

- A. Have the most tries at the UMBUZO quiz.
- B. Become the highest scoring class.
- C. Have the highest scoring Umbuzo player

Each Class can see their own individual leader board and in Achievement Assembly we will look at how the whole school is doing. We also want to be the top ODDIzzi school in the UK (if not the world), something we achieved one week in Mathletics having the highest scoring pupil as well as being top school!

The quizzes are set at two levels and are multiple choice. The pupils pick their topic area before they start and scores are entered onto the leader board, including any bonus points gained, at the end of the quiz after answering a simple question such as e.g. 'Which famous landmark would you like to visit in Greece?' (if the quiz subject was Greece). If children do not know the answers, they can go back to the main ODDIzzi site and learn all about the topic they have chosen.

Each class has its own password and login; to keep this simple the words are the same. Class teachers can provide this information for anyone who has forgotten or lost their details.
