

Year 5 London Trip 7th February

Just a quick reminder that our Year 5 trip to London will be on Tuesday 7^{th} February. Below is a quick check list of what children need for the day.

Checklist for London Trip

- Please arrive at school between <u>5:30 and 5:45am</u>. I would like all the children in the hall by 5:45 so we can register and check everyone has everything they need. The bus <u>WILL</u> need to <u>leave promptly at 6am</u> in order for us to get to our workshop on time. The bus company takes trips to London at least three times a week and have said that this is the latest we can leave.
- All children should wear school uniform and appropriate footwear not trainers. They will also need coats.
- Meals children should bring enough food for the whole day (breakfast if not eaten at home), lunch, tea and snacks to sustain them if required.
- Non fizzy drinks in re-sealable bottles/containers enough for whole day.
- Travel sickness medication if needed to be handed to Miss Fisher.
- Any other medication required (and on EV4 form) to be given to Miss Fisher.
- Book or non electronic game, colouring book, crayons etc to pass time on coach journey. Please do not bring valuable or electronic games as we can not be responsible for them.
- No phones please.
- Please put all food, stuff for day in a back pack or zipped bag, not a carrier bag as these rip and spill.

Spending Money

At parents discretion. We are visiting the Tower of London which will have a gift shop but as parents have already paid for trip, I am personally not convinced that children need to have spending money as well. However, if you do decide to give your child money, please can you make this a MAXIMUM of FIVE POUNDS ONLY (sorry, my laptop seems unable to do a pound sign!). This should be in a zipped purse or wallet labeled clearly with the owner's name.

We are expected to be back in East Bridgford at 7:30pm. I will update school regularly if this is likely to change either way. The bus company are confident that we will be able to keep to this time.
