Homework: Due in 11th October.

This week in science, we have been exploring the topic of food chains. The children have learned about the key roles in a food chain, including the producer, the primary consumer, the secondary consumer, and the tertiary consumer. We've thought about which animals are prey, predators and apex predators (at the top of the food chain).

For a homework project, I would like the children to get creative and design their own food chain. They can use drawings, cut-outs, or even make a 3D model if they wish! The aim is for them to show their understanding of the different parts of a food chain and how energy flows from one organism to another.

Please encourage your child to think about examples from nature—whether it's a land-based or ocean-based food chain—and to have fun with the project!
