As part of our Key Stage I 'Childhood' topic, we would like to set the children a project based around this. The project will entail children researching a toy or game from the past. This could be something your parents, grandparents or even great grandparents enjoyed when they were younger. You could choose a game or toy suitable for indoor or outdoor use.

For example:

- Artwork or a model of toys in the past.
- Investigate a timeline of how this toy may have changed e.g., Monopoly, Barbie, skipping ropes.
- Design and make a new game based on an original.
- · Researching homemade toys and try to replicate this in a creative way.
- Create and film an advert to sell a toy from the past.
- Produce a short video or PowerPoint.

We expect that this piece of work to be Take Care and to presented in a traditional 'St. Peter's' way. This being either presented on a poster, model, a diagram or writing with images.

We appreciate this project needs time and effort so we will be giving the children four weeks to complete this. Please do not bring in projects in any earlier than the deadline date as we want to ensure work is displayed together in our classroom and will spend time looking at each on the deadline date.
