All children will have the opportunity to have a class swap session with their new teacher on **Tuesday 5th July**. Parents will be informed before this date of their child's class teacher for September.

KS1: Year 1 and Year 2 will again have three teachers due to (the law) infant ratios of 30:1, therefore KS1 will be split into three classes as per previous years. Careful consideration has been taken to place KS1 children with teaching and learning at the heart.

LKS2: Year 3 and Year 4 will be fused this academic year into two classes due to pupil numbers across these year groups. We are aiming to bring LKS2 Year groups together for particular lessons with additional adult support where identified.

UKS2: Due to pupil numbers and other considerations of our Year 6 children (current Year 5 children), they will be taught by two teachers this academic year, thus keeping Year 5 (current Year 4) together as one class for this coming year. Year 6 will be split for registration purposes and over the year will be taught by both teachers in adjoining classrooms.

The Head Teacher's decision is final on class structure and which children are in each class. Careful and informed considerations have been made with teaching and learning at the heart of these decisions for this year and beyond.
