## **Covid update**

Firstly, we would like to wish everyone isolating at home a speedy recovery. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding during this term.

As we move to week 4 (and final week) of our local outbreak management plan, we have seen a noticeable decline in the numbers of children (and staff) isolating at home from a positive confirmed Covid PCR test, which is encouraging news. This week the numbers isolating at home have more than halved from week 2, which shows more children returning to school than testing positive. We are seeing full classes returning which is very good news. We must not however become complacent and continue with the reasonable measures in place, as we are still receiving confirmed Covid positive PCR results, but not currently every day. In total, so far since mid-November we have recorded just over 90 Covid positive PCR cases.

Both Notts Public Health Team and school Governors have been supportive of St Peter's throughout this local outbreak commending our Covid measures in place. Our daily communication with Notts Public Health Team have advised we keep measures in place for our last week of term and continue into the first week of the New Year. As a school, we will continue to keep current Covid measures in place. If reported Covid numbers do not increase we will return to before and after school activities from the second week back in January 2022.

Thank you to parents for following guidance and to those going beyond to be the safest we can be for both children and staff in school.
