

New Procedures for coming into school from June 1st

Many things in school have changed in preparation for some of the children returning to school. Please spend some time with your child/ren talking through the changes and ensuring they understand what they need to do when they return to school on Monday.



There is now a one-way system around the school. Enter the gate with your child and say goodbye. Follow the yellow dots painted on the floor and exit through the top gate.



When you enter the gate there will be cones for you and your child to follow. Adults will follow the yellow dots and children will go to the hand sanitiser table and use the gel provided.



Try to pump the pot with your elbow, but don't worry if this is too difficult to begin with.



All children will enter through these doors into the school (with the exception of Reception and Preschool children).

Enter through the red fire door which will be propped open.



Keep to the left and follow the arrows at all times.

You will be told which classroom you need to go to.



Children will enter the classroom, find their name and sit at the table.

Coats will go on the back of chairs and any bag will go under the table.

What does your child need to bring with them?

They will need to bring a set of coloured pencils with them in a pencil case. We will provide everything else. This pencil case will then stay in school until the summer holidays.

Do they need to bring anything else?

As we will be working outside for longer periods of time, each child will need to bring:

- a named sunhat each day
- a filled water bottle
- a named small bottle of hand sanitiser if they wish (this is optional as we will be washing hands very regularly).
