Key worker places have been sent out today at 4pm for this week and next week.

However, the request for places was much higher than anticipated and this will need to be reviewed during the next couple of weeks based on staffing and other considerations.

In the weeks to follow and in order to minimize the number of children and staff attending St. Peter's during the lockdown we are asking that where a parent is based at / working from home their child also remains at home and that the Critical Keyworker Provision is only used if and when there is no other option. The children in school will be accessing the same work as children at home. Please also take into consideration if you only require half a day of childcare.
