There is also a short activity for them to do if you wish to try this out.	Busy Bee time	<p>Below we have written down the sequence that we would be following in the classroom.</p> <p>If you have a go writing labels or short sentences with your child help them to sound out the word rather than getting them to copy it. We practise developmental writing in school, where we praise the child's efforts at sounding out words for writing. If they find them difficult help them to sound talk it and look at the letter grid to help them find the correct letters to write.</p>	<p>During this time, we would be doing lots of fine motor skills that lead to the correct holding of a pencil.</p> <p>We would also be practising 3 letters during the week.</p> <p>These do not all have to be completed by using a pencil and paper, although we have included some sheets as a guide if you choose to do so.
