In Year 3 maths we are continuing to explore place value, including exploring the value of each digit and flexible partitioning. We have explored making a three-digit number using base ten (pictures) and by using a part-whole model.

In English we have been working on using commas to extend our sentences. We have used commas when starting our sentences with fronted adverbials and when using adjectives to add in extra description in our sentences.

We are continuing to explore where the countries are in the world and capital cities of each country. We have also explored human and physical geography.

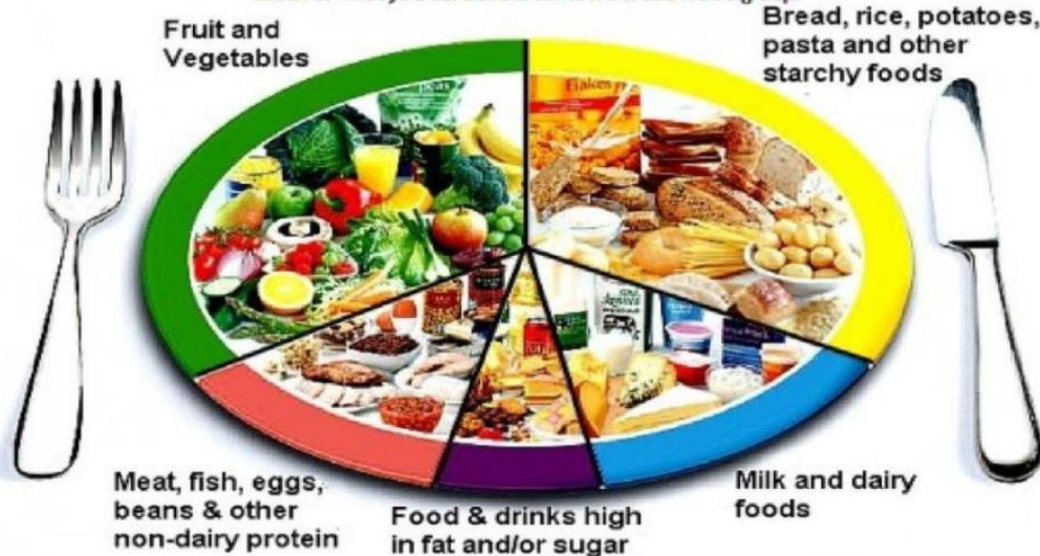
In history we are exploring a stone age settlement Skara Brae.
