Our Topic this term is **Emperors and Empires**

This week we have been learning about:

English: Narrative - The King of the Wishes

Maths: Fractions - with exchange and remainders

Topic: History - Romans **Science -** Plants **PE -** Dance and Cricket

Our Learning this Week:

This week in English we have begun a new unit on Narrative Texts. The story we have been reading is "The King of the Fishes" and the children have been learning to tell the story using actions and following a story map. We are following the talk for writing approach to learn the story and will be writing our own versions of the story over the next few weeks.

In Maths, both Year 3 and Year 4 have begun a unit on Fractions. Year 3 have been learning about numerators and denominators. We have also been thinking of the whole as 4/4 and 3/3 for example.

In History we have started our learning on Romans. This week we have placed the Roman Period on a timeline and have learnt that it covers both BC and AD time periods. We have begun to learn some of the significant Roman events, see if your child can tell you about any of these.

In PE on a Friday we have started a unit on dance. The children did a great job in today's session! We have been focusing on moving in time to the music. Over the next few weeks the children will build up to choreographing their own routines in groups.
