facilities.





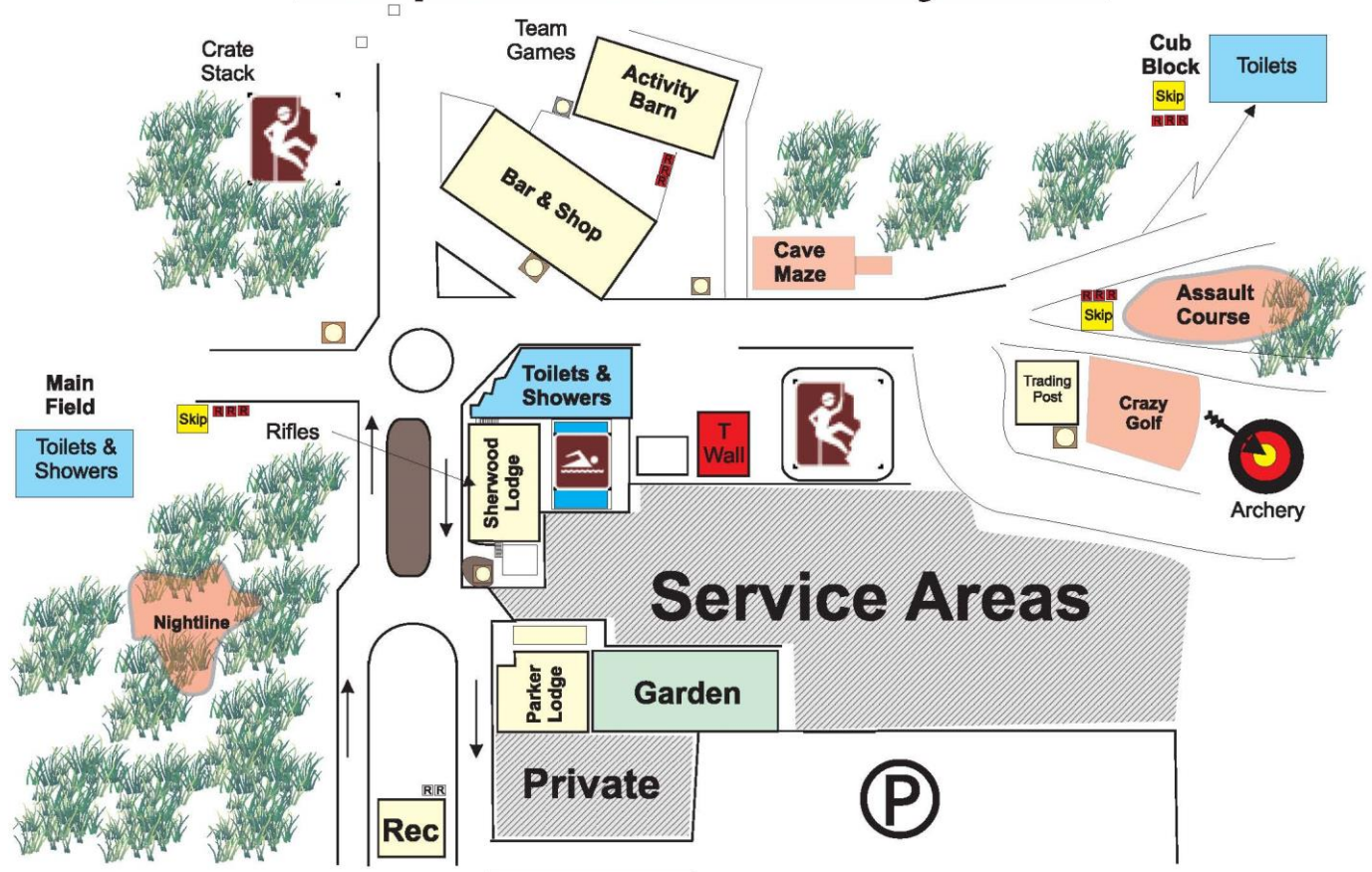




LODGES AND TENTED CAMPS ARE LOCATED CLOSE TO

# What to Bring? “The Kit List”



- ✓ Sleeping bag / Pillow & Pajamas / slippers/crocs rooms
