Thank you for supporting your child with the recent homework task about the game of tennis – we have certainly learnt a lot of new facts over the last few days!

The children have worked very hard once again this week and we have particularly enjoyed our science activities, working with a range of different magnets to test if different objects are attracted to them or not - there were some rather surprising results!

Just to remind you once again that times tables tests now take place on Thursdays with new sheets returned the following day. Spelling tests will now take place every Monday, (unless it is a bank holiday) with new lists handed out on Tuesdays. These changes are now in place until the end of the school year.
