## Curriculum:

In our work on Emperors and Empires this week we investigated how the Romans Ruled their empire. We have learned that there were three different types of rule. Find out if your child/children can remember them.

We collected and measured the width of the same species of leaf to see if the surface area was larger if the leaf grew in a shaded area. We recorded our findings on a bar chart.
