Yesterday and today we have learned all about Walter Tull, using his scrapbook and photographs to find out why he is such a significant character in British history. This has been part of study on Remembrance Day (please ask your child/children to tell you all about him, his story is fascinating with many highs and lows!) We have also visited our 'onsite' museum and looked at real artefacts from the war.

Curriculum:

In RE we have been learning about what kind of world Jesus would want. In English we have continued to develop our skills preparing us for next week when we will write our own biographies. In Maths we have been leaning how to add two 4 digit numbers with exchange using column addition and next week we will move onto subtraction.

HOMEWORK:

This week's homework is to retell the story of Romulus and Remus in the style of a comic i.e. telling the story using pictures and speech bubbles with a sentence or two for each picture. They can watch the story again on YouTube
