### **Curriculum:**

**English:** We have finished our stories and are purple polishing them and writing them up in neat. We have also done a lot of work about pronouns this week.

**Maths:** We are still working through our unit on decimals. We have another week on this and then we shall be covering work on money. Over the years I have noticed children having less and less access to spending money and working out change. Please can you support this unit by allowing your child to go to the shops with you and experience working out the cost of items and how much change they may need.

### **HOMEWORK:**

I would like the children to be creative and make something of their own choice related the Ancient Egyptians. We have discussed ideas but I am leaving the final piece up to each child. Suggestions are: A Tutankhamen mask, A sarcophagus and mummy, the pyramids or a hieroglyphics scroll. The children can use which ever medium they like; paint, model, fabrics, materials, paper, clay etc....

**I am giving the children three weeks to complete this, so it does not need to be returned before 7<sup>th</sup> June.**
