Curriculum:

In English we have started our new unit on Fiction writing. We are looking at a traditional story called 'The King of Fishes'. We shall learn the features and SPaG necessary to write our own story. We shall study new vocabulary and use a dictionary to find the definitions of our words and then use them in our own work. We started with a 'cold write' on Monday and will end with a 'hot write' -assessment piece at the end of the unit.

Topic for the term is Emperors and Empires. This week we looked at the timeline of the Roman Empire. In science we are studying plant nutrition and reproduction. We had a lovely walk around the school grounds; dug up some weeds and observed how the blossom on the trees will turn into fruit. In Maths both year groups are covering Fractions.
