Curriculum:

In English we have started our new unit on Fiction writing. We are looking at a traditional tale 'The Magic Paintbrush'. Our focus will be beginnings and endings. We shall learn the features and SPaG necessary to write our own story. We shall study new vocabulary and use a dictionary to find the definitions of our words and then use them in our own work. We started with a 'cold write' on Tuesday and will end with a 'hot write' -assessment piece at the end of the unit.

Topic for the term is Emperors and Empires. This week we looked at the timeline of the Roman Empire. In science we are studying plant nutrition and reproduction. We recapped the parts of a plant, expanding our knowledge to find out the function of each part. Next week we plan to walk around the school grounds; dig up some weeds, observe the roots and observed how the blossom on the trees will turn into fruit.
