## Curriculum:

In English we have we have learned the story of the King of the Fishes and added our own actions. We have looked at the plot in detail and started to plot our own stories ready to write them next week. We have also looked at the definition of words along with finding synonyms and sentence structure.

Our work on Emperors and Empires this week included using our research skills to find the answers to questions that we wanted answering. We now know many facts about the life of the Romans and their families in Ancient times.

In science we are studying plant nutrition and reproduction. We have learned the two functions of a root and the two functions of the stem. We know how the stem has a xylem and a phloem to carry the nutrients to the leaves and the flower. We did an investigation using celery and food colour to observe how the water travels up through these vessels. In Maths both year groups continue to work on Fractions.
