Firstly, as KS2 reading lead at St. Peter's, I would like to thank the PTFA for their donation for new books for the school library. Mrs Smith and I have started stamping them and putting them on the shelves - which is very exciting.

As always, the children are very proud of their work, and we try to share something with the rest of the school if we can. Today we shared some of our geography work with the whole school during achievement assembly (look out for photos in next week's whole school newsletter). The children have made models to help them remember the layers of the Earth. They were also able to articulate the features of each layer.

This week in geography, we looked at different rocks and identified metamorphic, sedimentary and igneous rocks from our extensive school collection. We learned how different rock was used for different purposes. Next week we shall learn more about fossils and the lady who spent her life looking for fossils on the South coast.

In science we continued to learn about forces and will look at friction next week. In art we drew thumbnail drawings of shape, form and pattern in nature and will use them to help create a motif for printing in future lessons. In RE we learned about different forms of prayer in different religions.

PE will continue Monday and Friday, but will move outside on Friday, so a warm outdoor kit will be required.
