Curriculum:

Next week we shall finish our work on Little Red Riding Hood and do some writing based on the play 'The Selfish Giant.' that the whole school will see next Tuesday afternoon. In Maths we have continued work on place value.

History continues to look at lives of the Stone Age and in Geography we have learned the capitals of different counties. Next week we shall learn about the rivers, deserts and mountain ranges that run through them. In science we have learned all about healthy eating and the 5 main food groups (consolidated by this week's homework). In RE we have discussed what Christians do and why they may wish to support others in the community.
