Curriculum:

In English we are still studying the book called Stone Age Boy and we have written a cold write journal entry, continued to develop our use of expanded noun sentences and conjunctions. In maths we have continued to work on tenths, placing them on a place value grid, recognising them on a number line and dividing decimals by ten.

Homework:

I would like the children to read the sheet about Wealth and power in the Bronze Age and choose to answer at least two of the questions on the question sheet. If they wish to do them all, even better! They can also choose how to present their answers, but it has to be 'take care' work that will make them feel proud as I will stick it in their Learning Journal along with other topic work.
