Curriculum:

We are studying Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, which links in to our new topic Scrumptiddlyumptious. We have discussed the structure of an adventure story, highlighted interesting vocabulary, thought of questions to ask Charlie and asked these questions during a Hot Seating session.

Our topic work has been lots of fun this week and we have sketched a composition of fruit and veg and made bread -which they brought home (still warm) today.

In RE we have begun studying the life of Moses and we have learnt more about democracy and the importance of asking questions in our work on British Values.

Mr Malplaquet has continued to teach the maths unit on decimals and fractions.

Homework:

Homework is to spend about half an hour on Purple Mash using the Multiplication app to speed test how quickly they can answer 25 multiplication questions. At the moment the timer has been set with a 6 second intervals. Can they reduce the interval time but still get all the answers correct? The children get the option to select which tables they want to test themselves on and over the next month I would like to see most children testing themselves on all their tables from 1-12.
