Curriculum:

Our Through the Ages work has now moved into the Iron Age. We have looked at the timeline of this period and have used our archaeology skills to recreate a Celtic warrior. We did this by reading about a warrior and piecing the evidence together to draw what we imagined him to look like.

In English we focussed on grammar to support writing a setting. This included varying sentence starters using adverbials, using commas to make lists and parenthesis to drop in extra information. We have finished chapter 2 of Stig of the Dump and discussed the answers to comprehension questions as a whole class.

In maths we have divided 1 and 2 digits by 10 as well as work looking at hundredths on a timeline and as decimals.

It has been our final week in IT coding and in RE we read the story and worked with charcoal to create pictures relating to Good Friday. We have started work on our British Values and this week we have looked at Democracy and the values to help someone be a good representative.
