This week in English we have looked at persuasive writing through travel brochures. We read examples of travel brochures from cities around the world, identifying persuasive language. We then researched tourist attractions in our local city of Nottingham which the children used to write their own brochures aimed at younger children.

In Maths, we learned how to identify different kinds of angles (acute, right and obtuse) and then learned how to compare and order angles.

Our topic this term is called 'Urban Pioneers' and in it we explore urban life. This week, the children looked at and compared maps of East Bridgford and Nottingham, discussing the differences between rural and urban environments. The children also explored patterns in our local environment through photography and sketching.
