Here's what we've been up to the past two weeks:


- In **English**, we have finished our unit on warning stories, with a particular focus on speech. Next week, we will begin learning how to write poems, exploring river poetry which ties nicely into our current **Geography** topic.
- In Maths, we have wrapped up our multiplication and division unit and have started a new topic on length and perimeter. This week, we've been revisiting measurements from Year 2, focusing on accurate measurements in centimetres, millimetres, and metres.
- In Geography, we have been exploring 'World Rivers' and the uses of Rivers, as well as the key features of mountains and understanding the different types of mountains.
- In **Religious Education (RE)**, the children have had the opportunity to create their own Hindu temples and have learned about the things typically found inside them and Hindus worship at home and in the community.
- In Design and Technology, we explored everyday objects such as a cushion and a lamp. We investigated the features of each object, such as material and functions. We've also been learning about the influential designer William Morris and how his work has influenced floral patterns and home designs.
- We were also very fortunate to have Life Education visit us. The children
 participated in a lesson called 'Meet the Brain' where they learned about
 the importance of the brain, the role of nerves, the digestive system, and
 how making positive choices can impact both our brains and our overall wellbeing.
- Finally, on Wednesday, we celebrated Chinese New Year! The children learned about the traditions in China and celebrations around the world. We also explored the Year of the Snake and discovered which animal corresponds to the year of their birthday (pictures in the Newsletter).
