Our Topics this week

English: Story writing, including adjectives and exciting vocabulary Maths: Place Value to 999, including comparing and ordering numbers Topic: Science - Skeletons, Music - Mamma Mia, ICT - Programming and Beebots

English

This week the children have been writing their own stories based on the production we watched earlier in the week - The Reluctant Dragon.

As part of our grammar sessions we have been learning/revising conjunctions, adverbs and adjectives. I have been challenging the children to use more exciting vocabulary and the children came up with some super sentences to describe the characters from the performance.

In Spelling, we have been looking at suffixes and prefixes this week and how they can change the meaning of a word. Ask your child to see if they can remember which ones we have been learning about.

Maths

This week we have continued with our work on place value and have extended the learning to involve numbers up to 999 for Year 3. The children have used a number of methods to partition different numbers, including base 10, part-whole method and using place value charts.


Towards the end of the week we focused on word problems and using our knowledge of the value of each digit to solve a range of problems.
