Our Topics this week

English: Editing and Improving our work, punctuating simple sentences, reading comprehension.

Maths: 10 more and 10 less, 100 more or less.

Topic: Geography - Grid references - creating maps with symbols, Music - Mamma Mia, ICT - Purple Mash, PE - Ball skills.

English

This week in English we have been focusing on the characters Farmer Hogget and Mrs Hogget from the story The Sheep Pig. We have been finding evidence in the text to tell us what these characters are like and interpreting the meaning. For example, in the story it says "Farmer Hogget is a man of few words", we then explored what this might mean. The children wrote character profile based on information they found in the text. We have also been using evidence from the text to create images of the range of settings within the story. As part of our grammar sessions we have been recapping sentence structure and ensuring that we punctuate a sentence with a capital letter and full stop.

Maths

In Maths we have been adding and subtracting multiples of 10 and 100 from three digit numbers. We have been using the formal method of column addition and subtraction to do this. It is important the children remember to write one digit per square when doing this to ensure that they are not confusing the different columns. The homework activities set on Purple Mash this week are a consolidation of these activities. Usernames and passwords are in the children's planners.
