We have started our new topic this week, Misty Mountains and Windy Rivers- geography based, and this links to our art topic Landscape (see homework)

Curriculum:

We are continuing our unit multiplication and division. This week we have looked at multiplying by 10 and 100. Next week we shall divide by 10 and 100. Multiply by 1 and 0 and divide by 1 and itself.

In science we are learning about states of matter and finding out whether things are solid, liquid or gas. Yesterday we had a very messy lesson playing with shaving foam, gels and liquids as well as gasses and solids. In Spanish we are learning how to say different vegetables, and in music we are learning about the orchestra. Our RE topic is call God's Kingdon and we are learning about the Pentecost. DT this term is functional and fancy fabrics.

HOMEWORK:

LKS2 will have two weeks to produce a piece of creative artwork linked to Misty Mountains, Windy Rivers and our art project Landscapes.
