We shall start the day practicing our handwriting and spellings.

## Curriculum:

We are really enjoying our new geography topic, Misty Mountains and Windy Rivers. I hope the children enjoyed the homework. It certainly looks as though many of you took a pleasant walk to the river, Gunthorpe bridge was a popular choice. This week we have learned how water can change the landscape, we have learned about erosion, transportation and deposition.

In science we have carried out a couple of investigation using thermometers to take the temperatures of melting ice-cubes and varying temperatures of water from cold and tepid to hot. We have learned the different scales to measure temperature, including Celsius, Fahrenheit and Kelvin

In art we have practiced our sketching skills and have looked at different methods using hard and soft pencil leads. In Spanish we are learning a song all about the different vegetables.

In maths we have been dividing a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number. Some children found this quite challenging. See homework.

**HOMEWORK:** Classroom secretes consolidation work. Developing, expected and greater depth. I have explained to the children that if they are struggling to do D and try E. Those more confident to do E and try GD.
