As well as learning doubles facts (e.g., 4 + 4 = 8, 7 + 7 = 14) provides a handy mental strategy for solving other addition problems. And, understanding how number bonds to 10 can help us to efficiently solve problems by breaking numbers into manageable parts.

English:

This week, we started our new topic, this will focus on storytelling involving a problem and exploring characters' feelings. We thoroughly enjoyed developing and using our own creative ideas to add action and drama whilst retelling the story, especially when the monkeys were jabbing back to the hat seller!
