What a busy couple of weeks we have had. Everyone has settled in well and routines are being established. One routine is that we read every day, so please remind your child/children to bring their reading books and work diaries in daily.

Thank you to those who have started signing the work diaries whenever you hear your child/children read, practise their spellings or times table (the children know which table they should learn for next week). It really helps show the children that we all work closely together.

On Monday we had a workshop all about **sleep**. The children were given advise how to help them sleep and the importance of sleep (repairing the body, growing, consolidating learning etc). The main advice was to switch off all electronic devices an hour before bed. The body needs to know it is going into sleep mode. Curriculum:
