Many of the local community are now asking how they may further support our school in these post covid times and with the present cost of living squeeze. Inevitably, school finances have become increasingly pressured, even with a strong team of staff, skilled governors and a Parent Teachers and Friends Association (PTFA) dedicated to securing the very best value for money.

How you could help support our school

The school has created an information leaflet all about **Pupil Premium funding**. This money, if your child is eligible, goes straight to schools and helps support children primarily for teaching and learning amongst many other things. The school's priority is staffing and where the majority of the budget goes, this is our most valuable and high impact resource. We have made cuts and savings elsewhere in the budget due to our other significant financial constraints. The school is quickly reaching the limit of any further areas of expenditure which can be cut and are negotiating school contracts to the tightest margin, including purchasing existing school laptops rather than leasing them through a less cost-effective long-term contract. Unfortunately, there are very limited savings the school can now make over the next few years. Capital money is tied up with paying for the roofing and heating works which have taken place over the past few years. Therefore, the school and the PTFA are asking you to come together, to help our fantastic school.

We are politely asking if you can consider donating to our JustGiving campaign to raise £25,000 for essential phonics books, the ambition of a newly developed playground/garden learning spaces and continuing to purchase quality learning materials for your children to use. **Any amount is appreciated**.
