Eg emails, calls, verbal correspondence to when access is required.</li> <li>Vehicle access is 'over and along' the playground. Cars should not be parked on the school playground, unless exceptional circumstances are mutually agreed.</li> <li>The gate is padlocked during the school day. Our neighbours have this code for their right of way.</li> <li>Vehicles not allowed on playground at break / lunch times unless extraordinary circumstances and only with permission / escort.
