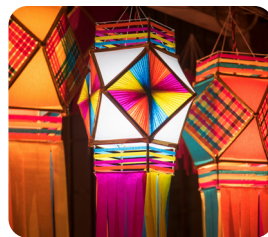

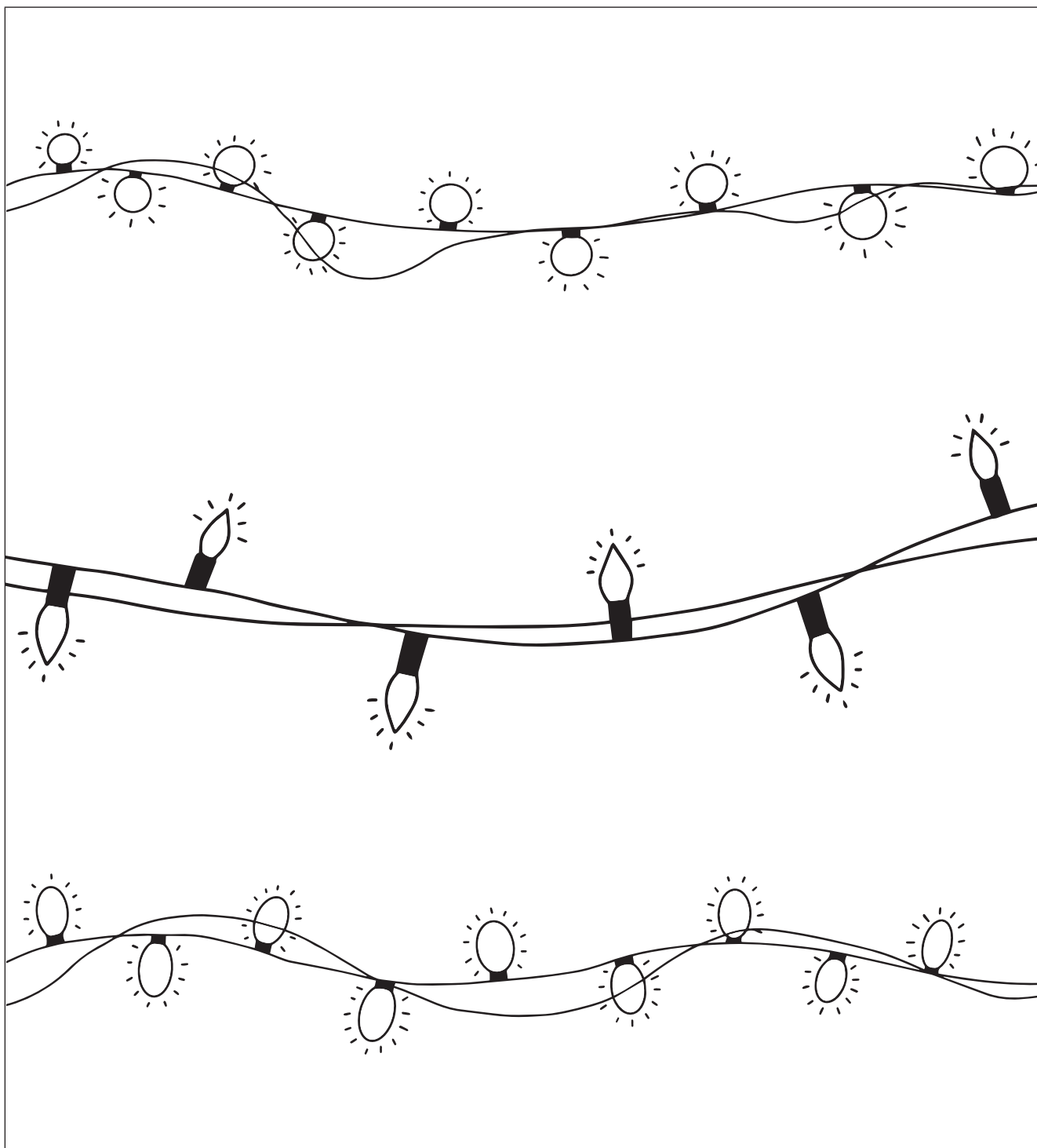
4. Sometimes when we celebrate, we send cards or messages to people we love. Make a card or write a message and send it to someone special.
