Another week of hard work! For the many children in Beech class who chose to take part in Young Voices — it's getting close, and we are all very excited — tickets and t-shirts should be with you shortly.

We enjoyed another 'Life Education Workshop' on Thursday (delivered by Jenny Lorimer) On this occasion the theme was the importance of friends and how we can help each other to make good decisions. The session began with a recap of previous workshops, building on our knowledge of staying healthy (including a workout to get heart rates up!). From this, we then considered the importance of making good choices through discussion, paired and group work and how to be a good friend and resist bad influences.

This week's other learning:

- Maths as well as keeping times tables ticking along, we have now completed our fraction unit which culminated in an assessment at the beginning of the week. We have now moved onto more multiplication and division work.
- English the children have en joyed the discussion focus of our 'Talk for Writing' and have written some excellent hot writes based on the title 'Should homework be banned?' there were some very interesting arguments put forward!
- \bullet DT we compiled a set of questions to ask Mrs Plumb based on how she organises the preparation of our school meals this fits in with the topic "Eat the Seasons"
- R.E. we have looked at important Hindu symbols and their significance.
- Science the children are finding this topic very interesting and have enjoyed classifying different plant cycles as well as learning about plant reproduction.
- Art we have considered the different techniques used for shading and produced some excellent results by using a soft, shading pencil.
