## **Maths:**

**Year 2:** The children have started a short unit of work on statistics. This week, they have created and interpreted a range of tally charts and pictograms. From these, they have been able to ask and answer questions about the information that is represented.

**Year 1:** The children have continued their unit on place value to 20. They have compared and ordered groups of objects and numbers in a variety of representations using the greater than, less than and equal to symbols.

## **Homework:**

In addition to regular reading and learning spellings/phonic patterns, I would like the children to have a go at the attached reading comprehension. Each child has a copy that is appropriate for them.
