



Once upon a time

Read together your favourite fairy tales, predict what might happen next, what happened in the story and encourage your child to join in repeated refrains

"They love I'll huff and I'll puff and will blow your house down"

Goldilocks loves porridge, can you have a go at making porridge with a grown up. Talk about your favourite toppings and maybe draw the recipe.

Can you make some biscuits, as if you were going to your Grandma's house? You could take a picture to show the rest of the class how you decorated them

Can you design and build your own bridge for the Billy goats, it needs to be strong enough for them to get to the other side.

This project supports children to develop a love of stories and reading. It encourages children to learn, retell and act out familiar and traditional tales including Cinderella, Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.

Baby bear loves to sleep with his favourite teddy bear. Do you have a favourite teddy?

Can you draw or paint a picture of it?

Cinderella's shoe was made out of glass, can you make one out of play dough or crumpled up foil and decorate it. Take a photo to share with your class.

Investigate what other animals might live in the woods? Talk about them and draw/ paint or collage your favourite one.
