Talk for Writing

We have been learning some parts of the Gruffalo's child. The children have been reading the story from the story maps and then retelling the story in lots of different ways.

Mathematics

We have been comparing numbers and looking at more, less and fewer. We have introduced the word 'least' which we will continue to practise over the next few weeks.

Literacy
