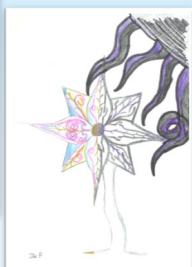

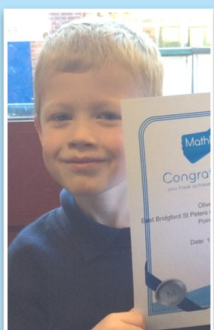


We're really proud of Matilda (year 1) for achieving 200 meters swimming. Well done!!

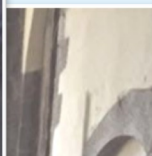
